Erasmus Theatre is a project of the European Theatre and Film Institute, unique in the following aspects:

Global Approach

- Students from two or several Art Universities of Europe and/or Asia are invited to come to Brussels for 2 months to work together under the guidance of experts from ETFI on Theater production (previously agreed with the university's program leaders)

Erasmus Internship

- The project is an internship under the Erasmus Internship program lasting for 2 months with Financial Support from Erasmus+:

Leading roles

- Unlike internships in large theaters, where students play as extras, at ETFI, students play leading roles and are active creators, with the support and mentoring of renowned professionals

Supervising experts

- Supervising is carried out by experts from ETFI and invited directors and professors with many years of experience in the profession. This reassures in depth learning of new acting techniques.

Advertising

- The names of all participating students will be included in the PR of this product. The project will be filmed and PR and video elements will be made available to participants for use in their portfolios.

Public Presentations

- the performance will be shown publicly to the vibrant, youth, student and mixt audience of Brussels at one of the theater stages of the European capital.
